Hardware Requirements

EditWriter and GenEDITS are MS-DOS based programs for the PC that require the following minimum hardware capacities:

- 80386 or higher processor
- 4 MB extended or expanded memory
- 10 MB available disk space

Runtime metafiles produced by EditWriter can be copied for use on Windows (3.1, 95 or NT), MS-DOS, UNIX, VAX/VMS, and other platforms. The CDC EDITS API and portions of GenEDITS may be recompiled for these platforms as well.

Installation Instructions

The files located here are used to install the CDC EDITS System along with the NAACCR and SEER metafiles of cancer registry edits.

You can install these files in two ways:

1. Download to Diskettes

- Automatic install using INSTALL.EXE will prompt you for an CDC EDITS directory (C:\EDITS) is the default). To use this, you will need three formatted 1.44MB diskettes.

- Download INSTALL.EXE and DISK1.EXE to disk1.
- Download DISK2.EXE to disk2, and DISK3.EXE to disk3.
- Put disk1 in drive A and type A:INSTALL
- The install program will prompt you for the rest of the installation.

2. Download to Hard Disk

- Manual installation without INSTALL.EXE (requires no diskettes). To use this, create a directory on your hard disk for CDC EDITS (example command: MD \EDITS)
- Download the DISK1.EXE, DISK2.EXE and DISK3.EXE files into the CDC EDITS directory.
- Change to the CDC EDITS directory (example command: CD \EDITS)
- Run the three DISKn.EXE files to extract the CDC EDITS software and associated files (example command: DISK1)
