<i>Address Window</i>	The Census Tract field deletes zeroes if they are placed in the field before the rest of the census tract value.	<i>The Census Tract field will retain leading zeroes for reference in the census tract value.</i>
<i>Change Focus Window</i>	The Change Focus window allows filtering but does not indicate the number of clients returned for the filter executed.	<i>The Change Focus window displays the number of clients found when executing the selected filter.</i>
<i>Main Client Bar Navigation Buttons</i>	When using the navigation button (<< previous and >> next) feature to modify data, an error can occur when answering Yes to the "Do you want to save?" prompt that causes data to mismatch between clients.	<i>Using the navigation button feature (<< previous and >> next) to modify mass records will no longer allow data mismatching between clients.</i>

<i>RVCT, Followup1 and Followup2 Windows</i>	When the user has not made any changes to these windows and chooses to close the window, the user will receive a "Do you want to save?" message.	<i>If the user has not made any changes and closes the window, the "Do you want to save?" message does not appear.</i>
<i>RVCT Window</i>		NEW FEATURE -- <i>A new button was created to allow user to print the Facsimile Report directly from the RVCT screen for the currently selected client.</i>
<i>RVCT Window</i>	Users must search through the anatomic code drop down lists alphabetically rather than by anatomic code.	<i>Q19 and Q20 display a drop down list of all anatomic codes along with the description.</i>
<i>RVCT Window</i>	When validations relating to the site of disease and anatomic code selections failed, the error messages received are vague and therefore not very helpful.	<i>Error messages relating to validation failures for site of disease and anatomic code selections are revamped to provide more detailed information on the specific anatomic code failure.</i>
<i>RVCT, Followup1 and Followup2 Windows</i>	To clear a date field marked as Unknown, the user has to make it Known and then Clear the field.	<i>To clear a date field marked as Unknown, the user just needs to select Clear.</i>
<i>Case Verification Window</i>	Week 53 is not calculated correctly.	<i>MMWR week calculation is now correct and week 53 will calculate appropriately.</i>
<i>Surveillance Browse Window</i>	Surveillance Browse window displays a line for each RVCT, Followup1 and Followup2 to indicate that data exists for the client.	<i>Only one line per client with check boxes to indicate that RVCT, Followup1 and Followup2 data exists for that client. All it takes is one glance to know what information is included for the client</i>

	<i>Current Version (1.1)</i>	<i>Update Version (1.2)</i>
<i>Facsimile Report Browse</i>	Browse window takes a long time to appear with the list of clients.	<i>Performance has been improved so that the client list appears incrementally as needed.</i>
<i>Facsimile Report Browse</i>	Only one client can be selected for printing the Facsimile Report.	<i>Multiple clients may be selected by holding down the CTRL key and highlighting required clients.</i>
<i>Facsimile Report</i>		NEW FEATURE -- When multiple clients are selected, the user may print the currently displayed report or may print all reports. It is not required to print all reports.

<i>All Test Windows, except Skin Test and Chest X-ray</i>	Worker information is not collected on the test windows, but shows on the Test Summary window for all tests.	<i>Worker information is collected on all test windows.</i>
<i>Test Summary Window</i>	The Test Summary Window does not display pending status appropriately.	<i>Test status was reworked and Test Summary Window will now display status of tests appropriately, including Pending status.</i>
<i>Medications Window</i>	When multiple users are simultaneously entering medications an "Integrity Constraint Violation" may appear when the pickups are being scheduled.	<i>Users will no longer receive an "Integrity Constraint Violation" when simultaneously entering medications.</i>
<i>Medications Window</i>	Performance is extremely slow when adding medications.	<i>Performance is much improved when adding medications.</i>
<i>Medications Window</i>	Pickups are automatically scheduled when adding medications.	<i>Users may now choose to NOT schedule pickups when adding medications. Users may schedule pickups at a later time or not at all.</i>

<i>Reports</i>	Exception Reports are located in the Daily Program Operations (DPO) Module.	<i>Exception Reports are truly Patient Management Reports. These reports have been moved to Patient Management Module for easier access by those who use them.</i>

	<i>Current Version (1.1)</i>	<i>Update Version (1.2)</i>
<i>Inbox and Outbox Windows</i>	User is not allowed to sort items displaying in these windows.	<i>Users may sort items displaying in these windows by clicking on any header.</i>
<i>Inbox and Outbox Windows</i>		NEW FEATURE – <i>A new filter was added to both windows to allow filtering on status date by providing start and end dates for the filter.</i>
<i>Inbox and Outbox Windows</i>	The only method to transfer data from TIMS L1s to RAs and from RAs to CDC is using the modem transmit feature.	<i>An email feature is added so that users may select the file to transfer and choose to securely email the file rather than transmit via modem. This feature uses your email application and user mailbox that is pre-configured on the client machine.</i>
<i>Inbox Window</i>	When assimilating SURV files, the user sometimes receives an “Integrity Constraint Violation.”	<i>TIMS Surveillance file creation and assimilation processes have been updated to prohibit “Integrity Constraint Violations” caused by F1 or F2 records traveling up without an associated RVCT and by appropriately handling records that are marked for Deletion that are already deleted from the higher level.</i>

<i>Data Dictionary</i>	When printing data dictionary users can only print by table and usage information does not display on the printed report.	<i>TIMS now provides an option to print the entire data dictionary that includes usage information. Users may also continue to print only one table but that printout will include usage information.</i>
<i>Frequency Report</i>	Frequency report displayed headers across columns and rows in no particular order when Display option was not defined.	<i>Frequency Report will sort headers in alphanumeric order across the rows and columns when headers are not defined with the Display option. Report layout is also improved to better enhance user readability.</i>
<i>Frequency Report</i>	Usage bubble help always appears and can be disrupting.	<i>Users may select to disable and enable the usage bubble help.</i>
<i>Ad Hoc Query</i>	When executing queries that include Outer Joins and searches for Missing data on those tables, the query retrieve all data instead of just the missing data.	<i>When executing queries that include Outer Joins and searches for Missing data on those tables, the query will retrieve the appropriate data.</i>
<i>Ad Hoc Query</i>	When executing queries with columns from different tables that are named the same, there is no way to determine which column is from which table.	<i>Table name is now included with the column name so that users can differentiate between rvct_eventstamp and client_eventstamp on the report.</i>

	When changing from module to module, users receive multiple messages indicating the module change.	<i>Extraneous messages that appear when changing modules within TIMS no longer appear.</i>
	When updating Global UDV data, the updated data are not getting transferred to the higher level.	<i>Updated Global UDV data is now being marked for transfer and included in the next transfer file.</i>
	Online Help is missing information on all changes made to TIMS since version 1.01.	<i>Online Help has been updated to include all features of TIMS (including those added in version 1.1 and 1.2)</i>
