

Acme Updates for Data Years 2008-2010

On January 4, 2010 all the ACME versions since Windows started failing when a data year was entered. They accepted no years, giving the user an "incorrect data year" error. All the ACME versions were working fine right up through 12/31/2009. Research showed an error in the date validation which comes up when the PC has a date with a year of 2010.

This only affects starting a new file in ACME. If you are using open file to process or edit a SuperMICAR-created file, things should work fine.

This affects ACME for all ACME versions since 2001.01, including 2008, 2009 and 2010.

Fixes for the executables for these three data years are available. Each year has its own update file so you can put the new programs in the appropriate folders.

To Run the updates:

- Download the file for the appropriate date year. The files are acme update 2010.exe, acme update 2009.exe, and acme update 2008.exe.
- Run each executable and when the Extractor box comes up, click on UNZIP.
- When it finishes, click Ok then close.

The default path is c:\mmds2008\ (or 2009 or 2010 depending on which you are running) but this can be changed before clicking unzip.
