# AMERICAN PSYCHIATRIC ASSOCIATION PROPOSAL FOR NEW CODES FOR: SUBSTANCE ABUSE WITH WITHDRAWAL ALCOHOL USE UNSPECIFIED WITH WITHDRAWAL COCAINE USE UNSPECIFIED WITH WITHDRAWAL

#### **BACKGROUND - I**



- A withdrawal syndrome may develop when a person with Substance
   Dependence reduces or stops use of the substance
  - most Substance Dependence codes include a 5<sup>th</sup> character of "3" for "with withdrawal" (e.g., F11.23 Opioid dependence with withdrawal)
- Substance withdrawal may also occur in clinical situations where the person is taking prescribed medication as directed and who is physiologically addicted but lacks behavioral elements required for dx of Substance Dependence
  - Substance Use, Unspecified with 5<sup>th</sup> character of "3" indicating "with withdrawal" for prescribed substances (Opioids, Cannabis, Sedative, hypnotic or anxiolytics, other stimulants); e.g., F11.93 Opioid use, unspecified with withdrawal
- Withdrawal can also occur with *other patterns of substance use* (i.e., less than Substance Dependence) in other non-prescribed substances (i.e., alcohol and cocaine)

#### **BACKGROUND - II**



- At September 2018 C&M meeting, APA requested withdrawal codes for cases of alcohol withdrawal and cocaine withdrawal occurring in individuals without dependence
- Received comments noted that substance withdrawal can occur in the context of Substance Abuse involving substances with the potential to cause physiological addiction, given that a diagnosis of Substance Abuse may involve frequent enough use to cause physiological dependence)
- Thus, APA is requesting new ICD-10-CM codes for substance abuse with withdrawal for those classes that can cause physiological addiction (i.e., alcohol, opioids, cannabis, sedatives, cocaine, other stimulants, and other psychoactive substance) in addition to the new codes for Alcohol use, unspecified with withdrawal and Cocaine use, unspecified with withdrawal proposed in September 2018.
