

CDC Budget

- CDC's [Budget site](#) provides information on CDC's and ATSDR's Congressional Budget Justifications, budget detail tables, operating plans, and budget fact sheets. The Congressional Justification document "justifies" the request by the President and explains the mission of the agency, outlines the goals and objectives of the coming fiscal year, and provides comparative data for the previous, current, and proposed budget. Once Congress passes annual appropriations bills, CDC and ATSDR develop operating plans based on their respective appropriations bills and conference reports.
