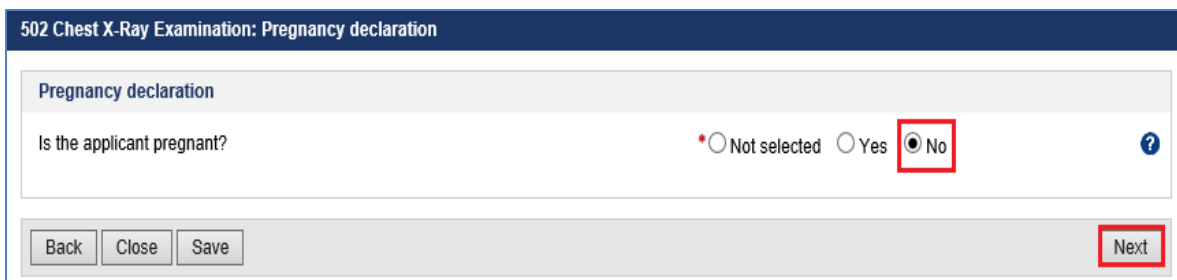


Tip Sheet: Managing Pregnancy in 502 – U.S. Health Cases

A pregnancy declaration must be recorded for female applicants aged 5 years and above.

Scenario 1 – Applicant is not pregnant

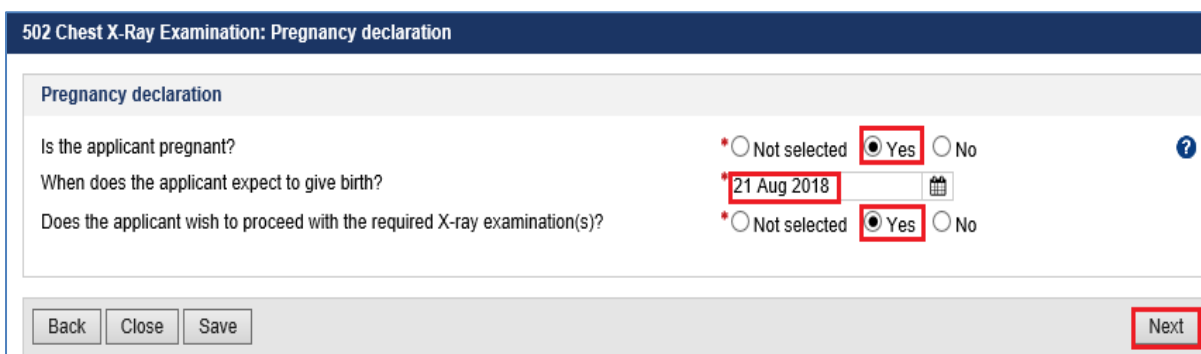
1. Select **No** for ‘**Is the applicant pregnant?**’
2. Press the **Next** button and proceed to complete the **502 Chest X-Ray Examination**

Scenario 2 – Pregnant applicant wishes to proceed with the X-ray examination

1. Select **Yes** for ‘**Is the applicant pregnant?**’
2. Enter the applicant’s expected due date into **When does the applicant expect to give birth?**
3. Select **Yes** for **Does the applicant wish to proceed with the required x-ray examination(s)?** question
4. Press the **Next** button and proceed to complete the 502 Chest X-Ray Examination

2. Enter the applicant’s expected due date into **When does the applicant expect to give birth?**
3. Select **No** for **Does the applicant wish to proceed with the required X-ray examination(s)?** question
4. Press the **Next** button

6. Press the **Close** button
