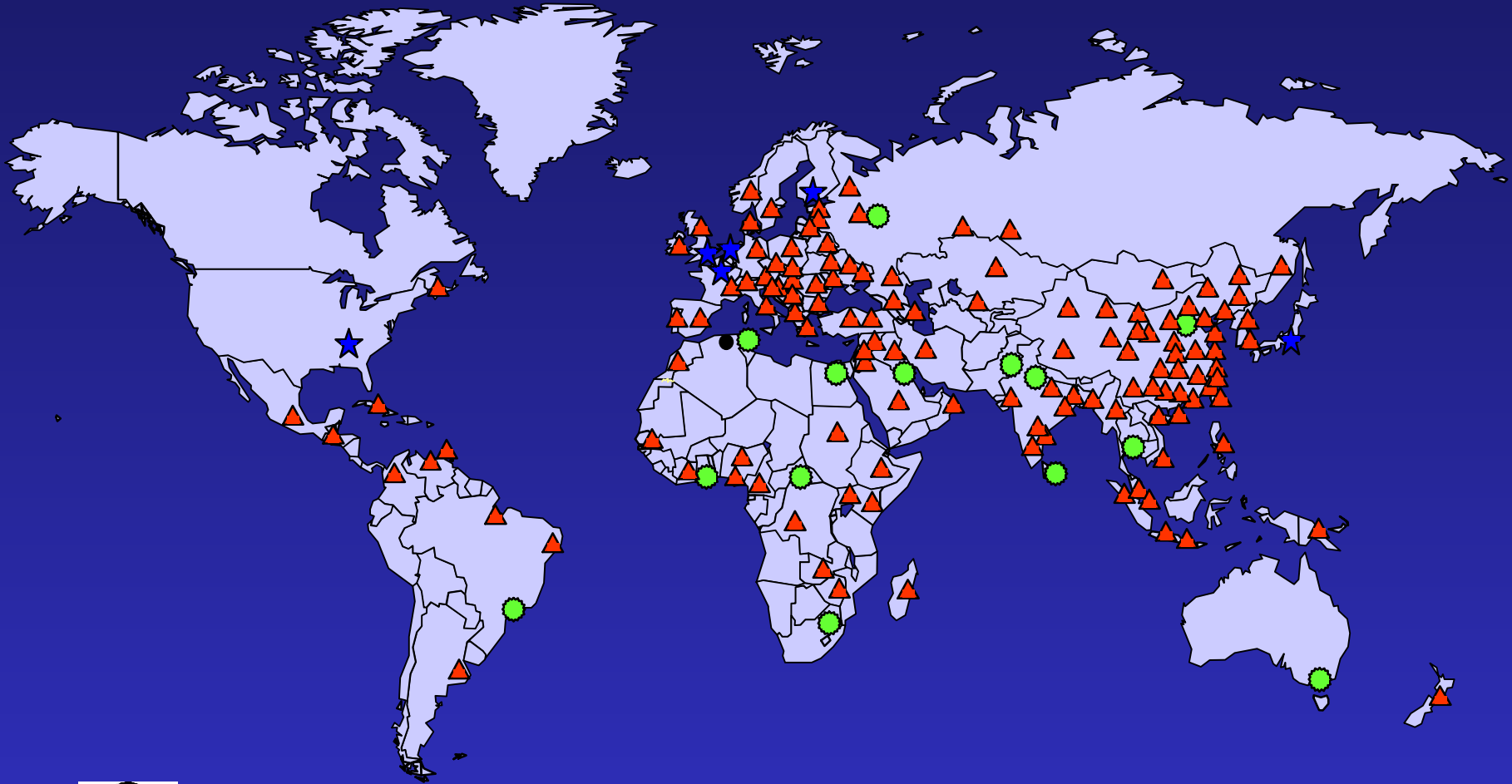

## 2. A Global Approach to Disease Surveillance Laboratory Network for Polio Eradication, 2000

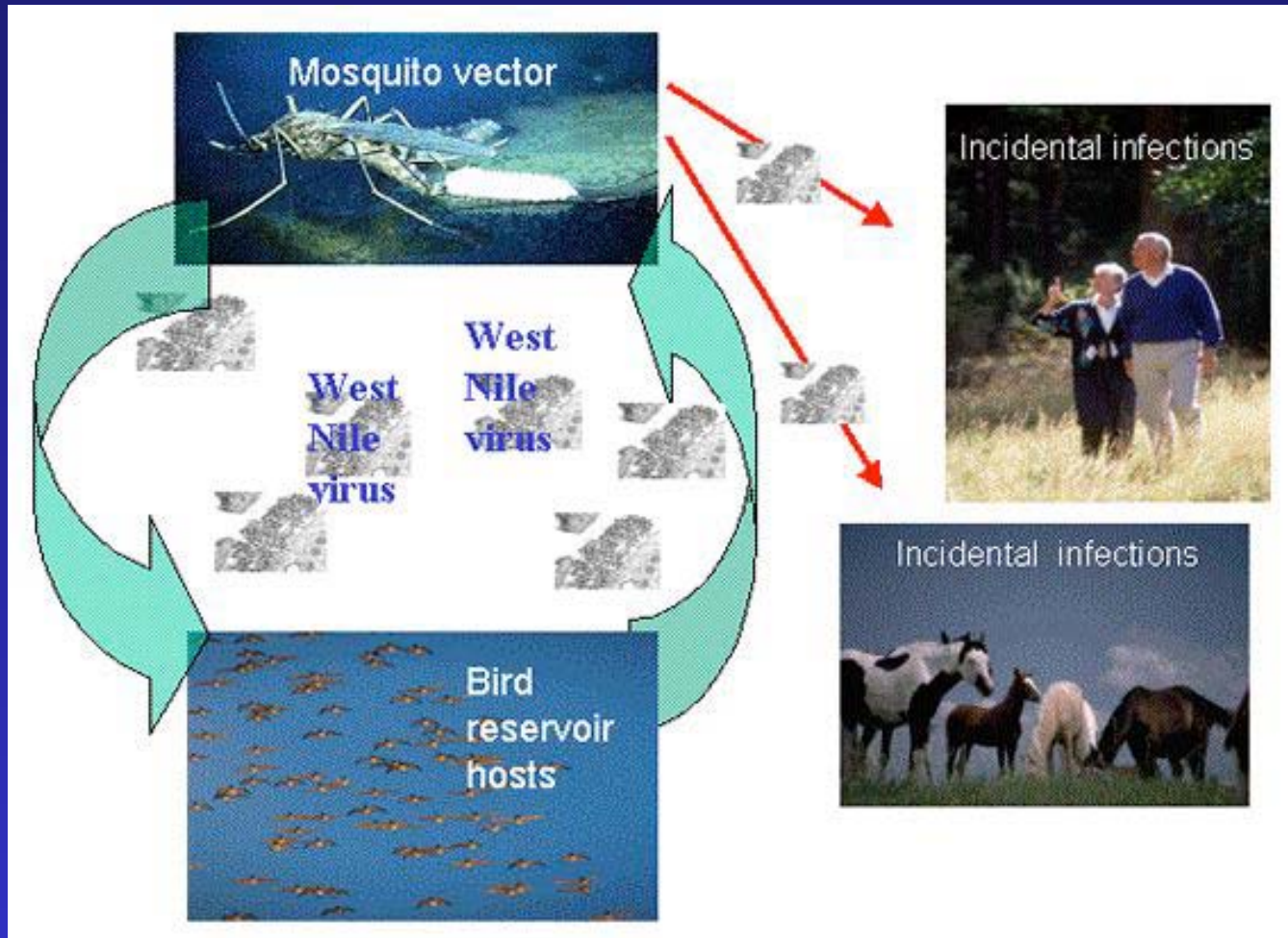
