## Make a Project File (PRJ) for an Epi Info SQL Server Project

The **EpiInfoCRC** package includes an Epi Info<sup>™</sup> 7 SQL Server database called **EpiInfoCRC** which is to be configured on a database server. The package also includes Epi Info<sup>™</sup> 7 and a project called **EpiInfoCRC**. The project file (**EpiInfoCRC.prj**) that is present in the **EpiInfoCRC** folder is configured with a default connection string. In order to update the connection string, you will need to create a new Project File for the EpiInfoCRC project. To create a new Project File, follow these steps:

1. From the Epi Info™ 7 Form Designer tools menu, select Make PRJ File.

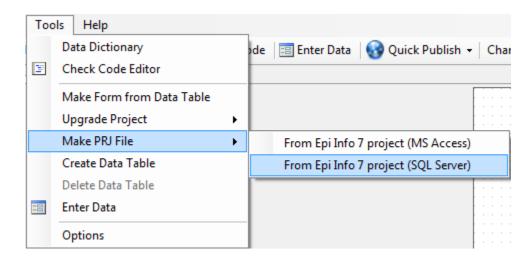


Figure 1: Epi Info™ Form Designer Tools menu showing the Make PRJ File options.

- Select From Epi Info 7 project (SQL Server) to create an updated project file for a SQL Server project.
- 3. Provide the connection information for the SQL Server database. Below is a screenshot with the default information. If the information changed during the SQL Server configuration, then use the updated information.

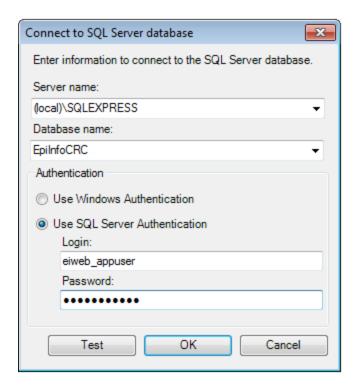


Figure 2: Connect to SQL Server database dialog

- 4. Click **Test** to confirm the connection
- 5. Click **OK** to browse to the location of the **EpiInfoCRC** project which can be found in **Epi\_Info\_7\Epi Info 7\Projects\EpiInfoCRC** folder where Epi Info 7 has been copied.

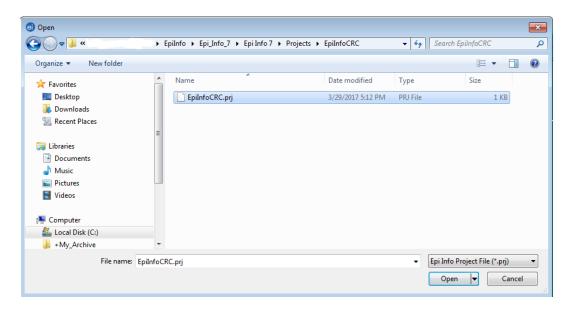


Figure 3: Open File dialog

6. Select the **EpInfoCRC.prj** file and click **Open** in the file dialog, then click **Yes** when the **Project** already exists dialog appears.

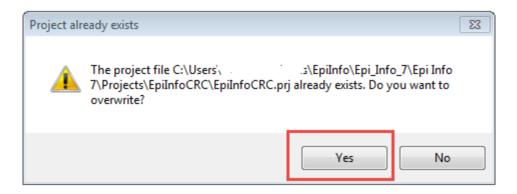


Figure 4: Project already exists dialog

7. You will receive a confirmation that the **Project file created successfully**.

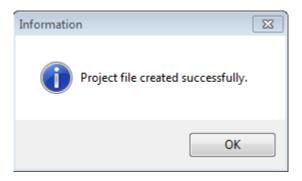


Figure 5: Project file creation successful message
