## Faculty and Staff Health Promotion

## About SHPPS

SHPPS is a national survey periodically conducted to assess school health policies and programs at the state, district, school, and classroom levels. Results from SHPPS 2000 are published in the Journal of School Health, Volume 71, Number 7, September 2001.

■ 20.0\% of states, 28.2\% of districts, and 29.5\% of schools have a person who oversees or coordinates health promotion activities or services for school faculty and staff.

- $76.1 \%$ of schools make school physical activity facilities or equipment available for the school's faculty and staff to use.
