Comments The original baseline was revised from 62 percent to

45 percent as the result of fundamental changes in

methodology. The target was proportionally

adjusted from 85 to 57 percent to reflect the revised

baseline using the original target-setting method. The original text was revised as the result of changes in the criteria and changes in the reporting system.

Although this objective tracks the same measure as Healthy People 2000 objective 20.18 (percent of persons with TB infections who complete therapy), the data source used to monitor the Healthy People 2010 objective differs from that used to monitor objective 20.18.

For some measures, data do not meet the criteria for statistical reliability, data quality, or confidentiality and have been suppressed. Information on suppression of data for the major Healthy People 2010 data systems has been published in a *Healthy People Statistical Note*.²
