Valid Codes

- 1. The following new categories were added by the WHO and are effective in 2009. They have been incorporated in Table A and the ACME Causal and Modification Decision Table
 - A09 has been expanded from a 3-character category to a 4-character category. The new 4-character categories are:
 - A090 Other and unspecified gastroenteritis and colitis of infectious origin A099 Gastroenteritis and colitis of unspecified origin
 - K523 Indeterminate colitis
 - R263 Immobility
 - R636 Insufficient intake of food and water due to self neglect
- 2. Category K51.1, Ulcerative (chronic) ileocolitis, was deleted by WHO. Ulcerative (chronic) ileocolitis will be coded K510.
- 3. The following codes will not be used by the US registration areas beginning in 2009. The conditions assigned to these categories are interpreted as poisoning:
 - F11.0, F12.0. F13.0, F14.0, F15.0, F16.0, F17.0, F18.0, F19.0
- 4. Change dictionary terms which cause pneumonia to be convert to hypostatic pneumonia from R99 to R263
