referral without payment.

This objective moved from developmental to measurable at the Healthy People 2010 Midcourse Review. The original objective text focused on the number of persons seen in primary health care settings who received mental health services. No data source existed for measuring the objective using the previous language. Revising the text made the objective consistent with the data available in the new data source.
