## Comments

Baseline data for smoking during pregnancy are for 46 States, the District of Columbia, and New York City. Data on smoking during pregnancy were not available for California, Indiana, New York State (New York City did report), and South Dakota.

Due to comparability issues between the data on tobacco use during pregnancy from the 1989 and 2003 revisions of the U.S. Standard Certificate of Live Birth, tracking of this objective ended in 2002, the last year before States began to implement the 2003 revisions.<sup>1</sup>

The measure tracked by this subobjective is identical to one the measures monitored by Healthy People 2000 objective 14.10.
