- A network of partners that **extends your philanthropic impact**





HI-5: Health impact in five years

CDC's HI-5 initiative shifts focus beyond traditional clinical healthcare approaches to approaches that improve population health and health equity. To advance Hi-5, the CDC Foundation will bring together a consortium **to identify policies associated with the initiative's community-wide interventions and support for policy implementation.**



Analyzing the health of 500 U.S. cities

We are working with CDC to conduct data analysis for the 500 largest American cities, and the census tracts in cities, to **identify, analyze and report data for 27 chronic diseases.**
