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CDC NPCR Data Requirements

- All reporting sources/agencies/organizations interconnected
- CDC data collection requirements
- CCRs not limited by CDC data collection requirements
 - CDC strives to accommodate all programs' needs



Radiation Treatment Data Items

- **RX Summ—Radiation [1360], Rad-Regional RX Modality [1570]**
 - Required 2006-2017 diagnosis years
- **Convert to Phase I Radiation Treatment Modality [1506]?**
 - Code “99” = Treatment radiation modality unknown; Unknown if radiation treatment administered
- **Discrepancies between RX Summ—RT and Rad-Regional RX**
 - 74,725 records 2006-2016
 - Only using Rad-Regional RX would code as “99”
- **Rad-Regional RX “Combination” and “Other” codes**
 - 60,174 records 2006-2016 would code as “99”
- 135,899 would convert to code “99”



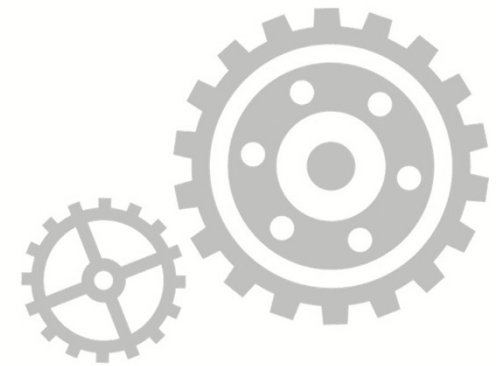
Radiation Data – What to Do?

- If data converted:
 - Data in previous items (1360, 1570) still available in registry databases
 - Consider including those items in analytic files
 - May be possible to identify “99” cases that received treatment
 - Requires additional data items
 - RX Date Radiation [1210]
 - Reason for No Radiation [1430]
- Probable changes to Phase I codes
 - Code “98” probably added

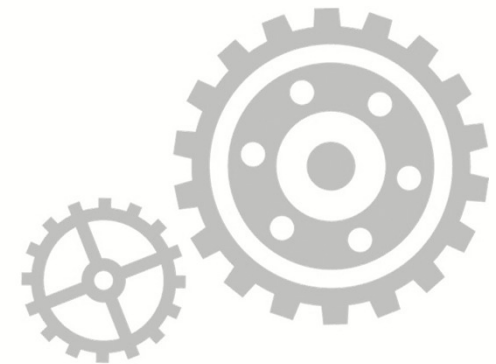
NPCR CSS Data Submission 2019

- Submit 1995-2017 in November
- Submit 2018 in January
 - Data items same for both files
 - Both files to be processed through NAACCR*Prep
 - 2018 not required to be error-free
- Completeness and quality standards
 - No change for 1995-2017 diagnosis years
 - Assessed for 2018 diagnosis year
 - Not used as criteria for Program Standards
- Allows documentation of impact
- NPCR Certificates of Recognition
 - Change impact letter to registry officials
 - No category for Registry of Excellence



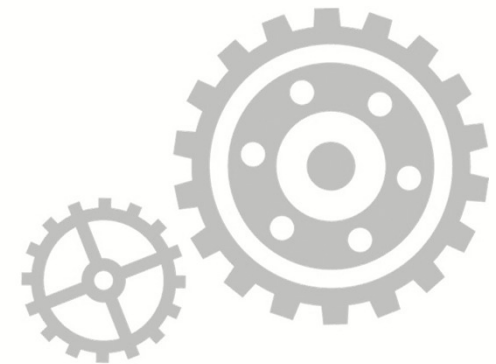
NPCR CSS Data Submission 2020

- Submit 1995-2018 in November
- May submit 2019 in November or January 2021
- No change in completeness and quality standards



CDC Data Requirements 2021
