
RNL and ICRC involvement

- Washington State Department of Health is the network leader for the region
- Geographically large region (HHS 9 & 10) with multiple time zones – 8 states, 6 U.S. Affiliated Pacific Islands
- 4 states with CORE VIPP funding from CDC (★)
- Currently no CDC-funded ICRC in region




WPIPN Injury Control Research Center Interactions
