FY 2014 Appropriation – NCIPC

- ❑ **Total funding = \$150.8 million**

- ❑ Increase of \$11.9 million over FY 2013 post-sequestration level


- ❑ **New “Injury Prevention Activities” line = \$29 million**

- ❑ Increase of \$2.3 million over FY 2013 post-sequestration level

- ❑ **NVDRS = \$11.3 million**

- ❑ Increase of \$7.9 million over FY 2013 post-sequestration level

FY 2014 CDC Appropriations



FY 2015 President's Budget - NCIPC

- ❑ **Total funding request = \$194.3 million**

- ❑ Increase of \$43.5 million above FY 2014

- ❑ **Proposed increase supports**

- ❑ **+\$15.6 million:** PDO initiative through Core VIPP

- ❑ **+\$12.2 million:** NVDRS expansion to all 50 states and Washington D.C.

- ❑ **+\$10 million:** Gun violence prevention research

- ❑ **+\$5.6 million:** Evaluation of rape prevention and education activities

FY 2015 Appropriation Process

Senate Mark

- Supports PDO initiative (not via CORE VIPP)
- Supports partial NVDRS expansion
- Increases funding for unintentional injury activities
