Communication in Public Health

- Scientific development and strategic dissemination of accurate, accessible, and understandable information
- Diverse audiences
- Audiences spread over wide distances with varied access
- Use of collaborative learning environments to develop, test, and share ideas
- Increasing need to have group-to-group communication to address shared risk and protective factors

Outlook Email Distribution

- Restricted capacity requiring direct management
- Dependence Information Controlled by Owner
- One Size Fits All
 - Information Sharing one-toone or one-to-all

ListServ

- Wider Capacity / selfmanaging
- Autonomy Managed by Owner but individual members control information
- Information sharing and collaboration one-to-all or one-to-group, or group-togroup
