Pediatrics Bed Availability for NY City Metro Region







(1) Refer only means the laboratory has established procedures for the collection and handling of specimens for referral to another designated network laboratory, but does not otherwise process the specimen.
(2) Rule-out means the laboratory will perform testing to the extent that the agent tested for can be determined as not present. If an organism is isolated that may represent the agent tested for, the laboratory refers the isolate to a higher level laboratory.
(3) Presumptive identification means the laboratory supports test protocols for the identification of agents but must refer the specimen / isolate to a higher level laboratory for confirmation testing.
(4) Testing capacity is categorized as Low (1 to 10 specimens/day), Medium (11 to 100 specimen/day), or High (more than 100 specimens/day). NS means the laboratory has not reported its testing capacity.
(5) Stat Response means the laboratory is prepared to respond within four hours to requests for testing and to maintain operations 24 hours/day for a minimum three days.

Conclusions

- Integrated, standards-based health information infrastructure is a key asset to health preparedness and response planning.
