Subject HANDLING OF NICKEL 63 (NI 63) SOLUTIONS



This memo is in reference to our discussion the other day about safety and internal requirements involved in the use of Ni-63 solutions. The requirements, as I gathered from the discussion, are very limited and are as follows:

- 1. The solution will have to be properly identified in use.
- The solution will have to be stored in proper containers and identified.
- The solution will have to be eventually disposed of in a method prescribed for radioactive wastes.
- 4. There is no danger to our special requirements for an operator using the small volume plating bath except as apply to acid solutions.
- 5. No special handling is required for rinse waters.
- No special handling of part except to identify radioactive part in packaging.
- Naskants can be disposed of by normal procedures.

If there are any areas that you feel need additional caution and/or clarification, or if there is any misinterpretation on my part will you please advise.
