

Healthy People 2010 Operational Definition

9-11. Increase the proportion of young adults who have received formal or informal instruction before turning age 18 years on the following reproductive health issues: abstinence, birth control methods, HIV/AIDS prevention through safer sex practices, and sexually transmitted diseases.

9-11g. (Developmental) Formal instruction in prevention of sexually transmitted diseases through safer sex practices: Females.

Comments

This subobjective was added during the 2005 Healthy People Midcourse Review. An operational definition could not be specified at the time of publication.

The proposed national data source is the National Survey of Family Growth (NSFG), CDC, NCHS.
