Comments	The original baseline of 17.7 deaths per 100,000 children aged 5 to 9 years was revised to 17.2 deaths per 100,000 as a result of changes in methodology. The target was proportionally adjusted from 12.3 deaths per 100,000 children aged 5 to 9 years to 13.0 deaths per 100,000 to reflect the revised baseline using the original target-

setting methodology.
