Comments	The original baseline of 95.3 deaths per 100,000 persons aged 20 to 24 years was revised to 92.7 deaths per 100,000 as a result of changes in methodology. The target was proportionally adjusted from 49.0 deaths per 100,000 persons aged 20 to 24 years to 41.5 deaths per 100,000 to reflect the revised baseline using the original target-

setting methodology.
