Public Use

The following terms are used in the Home Care tape format and are defined:

- 1. Home Care Section (pages 34-39 (1979) and pages 38-43 (1980) of questionnaire). Questions were asked of all respondents. This set of questions was used to define the need for personal (individual) home care as a result of a chronic health condition as well as the use of special equipment and special aids. These items also cover the use of eyeglasses, contact lenses and hearing aids.
- Needing Help Questions 1, 2 and 6e in Home Care Section specify "receive or need help from another person." Needing help is used here to mean receiving and/or needing personal help; it is assumed that those receiving help need it but <u>not</u> the converse.
- 3. <u>Stay in Bed</u> (Question 3) and <u>Doesn't Do</u> (Question 1) It is assumed that persons who stay in bed all or most of the day, or who do not do activities such as walking, need personal help.
- 4. Individual Home Care Section (IHC) pages 40-41 (1979) and pages 44-45 (1980) of questionnaire). Questions asked only of those needing personal home care (see Item 5 for definition). Set of questions to determine who actually received personal home care, type of home care provider, transportation, telephone, visiting, etc. For those not needing care, section is blank.
- 5. <u>Personal/Individual Home Care</u> (H box, Chr. 468:1). Anyone satisfying one or more of the following conditions:
 - A. "Doesn't do" one or more of 7 activities in Question 1 (Chr. $506 \neq 0$).
 - B. Needs/receives help with one or more of 7 activities in Question 1 (Chr. $508 \neq 0$).
 - C. Needs/receives help with one or more of activities in Question 2 (Chrs. $509-510 \neq 17$).
 - D. Stays in bed all/most of time Question 3 (Chr. 511 = 1).
 - E. Needs help for urinary/bowel device Question 6e (Chr. 522:1).
