The Annual Report on Osteopathic Medical Education is fielded annually to all accredited medical schools in the U.S. granting the D.O. degree. The survey is used for accreditation purposes and the response rate for both the survey and this question is generally 100%.

Objective 1-7 moved from developmental to measurable status at the Healthy People 2010 midcourse review. Eight subobjectives were created, addressing the core competencies of health promotion and disease prevention counseling and cultural diversity in the training of medical doctors (M.D.), osteopathic doctors (D.O.), baccalaureate nurses (B.S.N., B.A., or B.S.), and nurse practitioners (N.P.).
