Gravity Use Cases

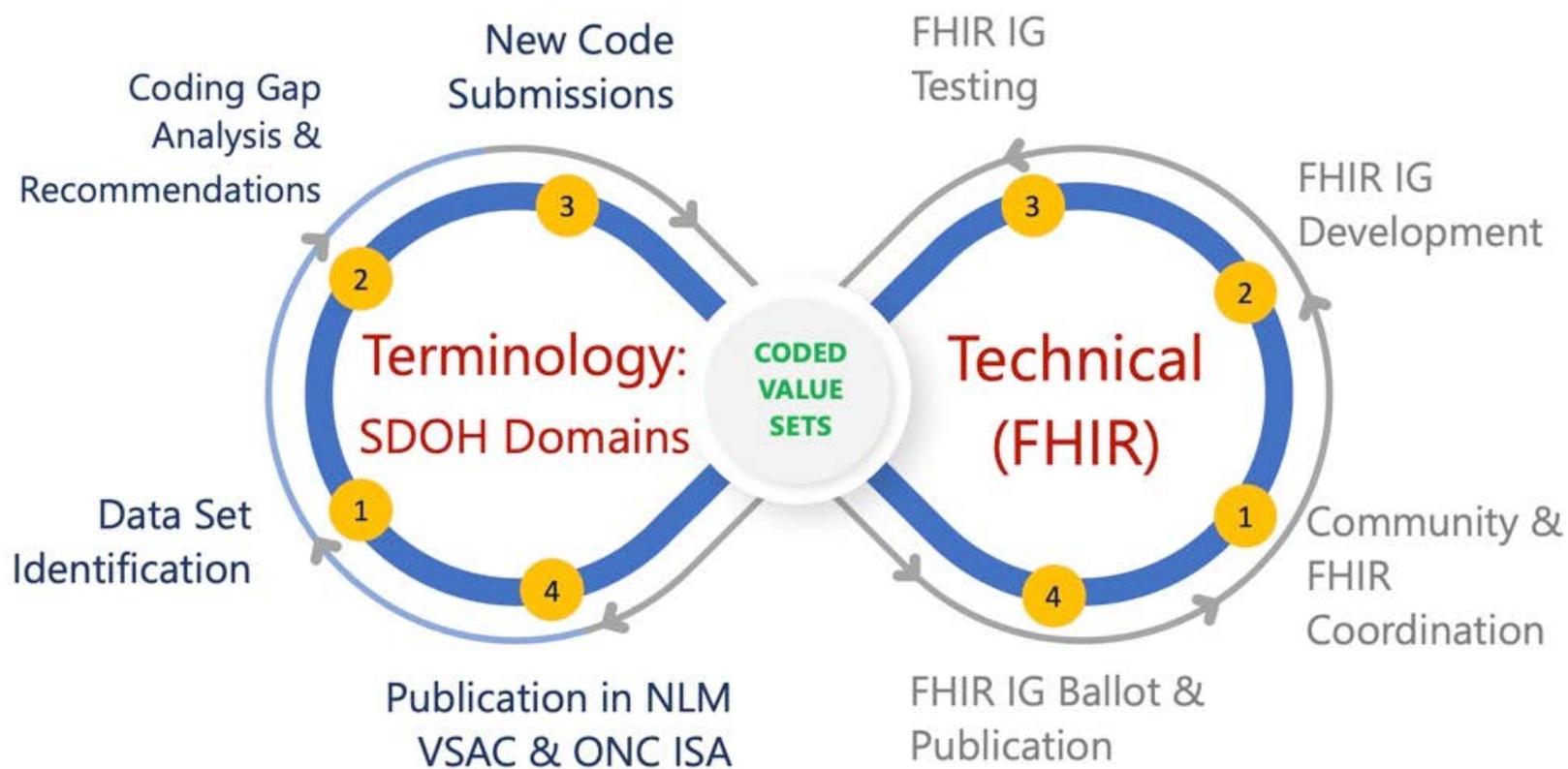
1. Document SDOH data in conjunction with the patient encounter.

2. Document and track SDOH related interventions to completion.

3. Gather and aggregate SDOH data for uses beyond the point of care (e.g., population health management, quality reporting, and risk adjustment/risk stratification).

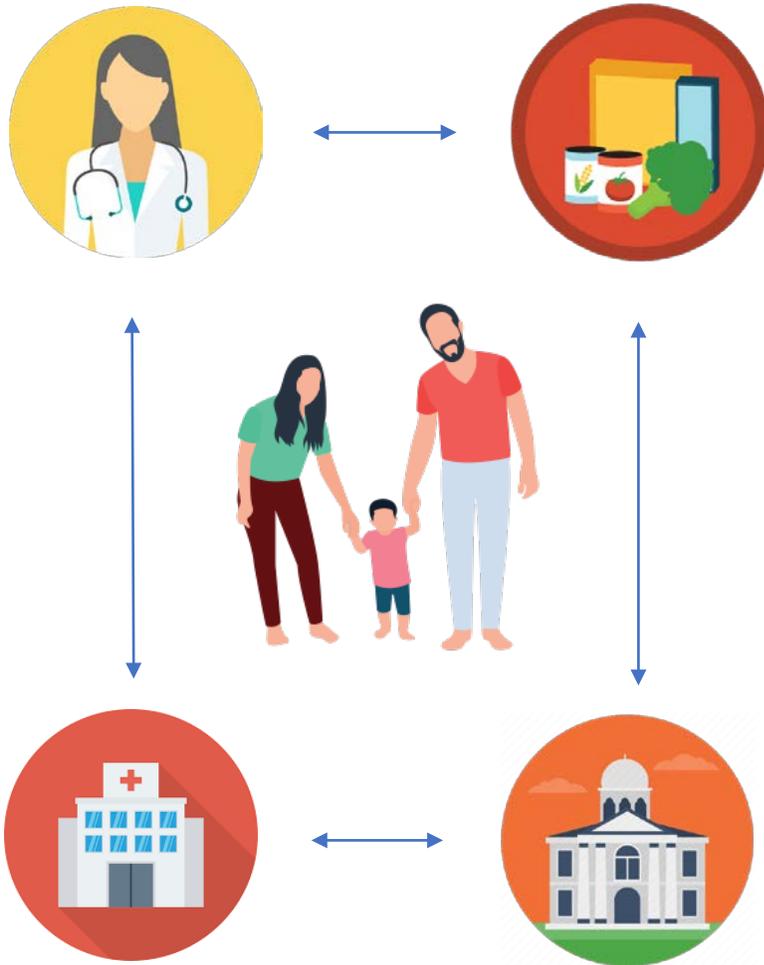

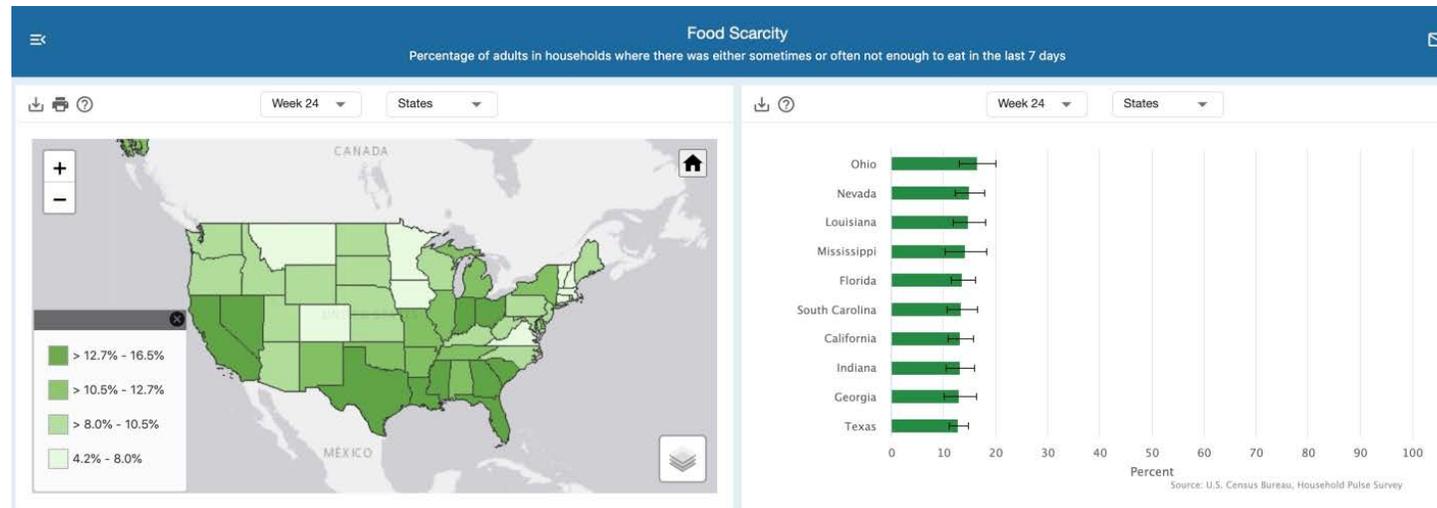

Clinical Significance of the Submission: Food Insecurity



Healthy People
2030 Objective

- Food Insecurity 
 - Increased rates of each of poor child and maternal general and mental health and increased rates of the CDC 10 diseases of concern ¹
 - *“Patient with COPD and DM- readmission driven by inability to follow recommended diet after discharge”*



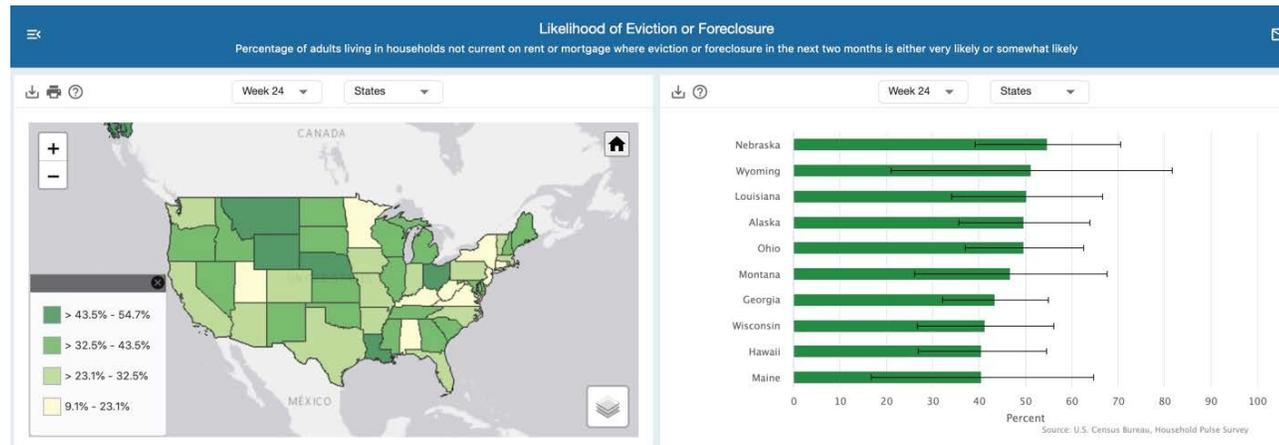

Clinical Significance of the Submission: Housing Instability



- Housing Instability 

- Including: Housing Cost Burden, Risk of Eviction, Multiple Moves, etc
- Increased rates of poor maternal mental and poor general health and child developmental risk ^{2,3}
- *“Mom and three young kids- struggling with depression, behind on rent and at risk of eviction”*

Clinical Significance of the Submission: Homelessness and Transportation Insecurity



Healthy People
2030 Objective

- Homelessness 
 - Key point is ***stratification into sheltered and unsheltered to aid in necessary chronic and acute care and discharge planning***
- Transportation Insecurity
 - Delayed or missed care, barriers to care plan, increased care coordination requirements ⁴ 

Clinical Significance of the Submission: Financial Insecurity and Material Hardship



Healthy People
2030 Objective

- Financial Insecurity, NEC
 - Including Financial Strain, bankruptcy, and burdensome debt
 - Increased poor mental and general health
 - Indicator of other economic SDoH
- Material Hardship, NEC
 - Including inability to obtain clothing, utilities, childcare, and other basic needs
 - *Able to apply to digital inequities leading to poor healthcare/education access during the pandemic*

Clinical Significance of the Submission: Physical Environment and Health



- Z58 Problems related to the physical environment 
 - Healthy People 2030 Goal: Promote healthier environments to improve health.
 - Z58.6 Inadequate drinking-water supply 
 - Healthy People 2030 Goal: Increase the proportion of people whose water supply meets Safe Drinking Water Act regulations

Clinical Significance of the Submission: Education, and Veterans



- Less than a high school diploma 
 - Decreased life expectancy and increased rates of chronic disease and poor reported health⁵
- Personal history of military service
 - *Previous concept did not apply to Veterans, only deployment*
