Diagnostic Recode #2 Acute Conditions

<u>Purpose</u>: Recode #2 consists of 32 2-digit categories of frequently reported acute conditions. These acute condition categories have been selected from the more extensive diagnostic listing in Diagnostic Recode #1 following definitions shown below. Categories shown in this recode are used for summary tabulation and publication purposes.

<u>Definition of Acute Condition</u>: For the purposes of the National Health Interview Survey an acute condition is any disease or injury with onset in the 3-month reference period prior to the week of interview, <u>exclusive</u> of certain conditions always classed as chronic regardless of the date of onset. The <u>incidence</u> of acute conditions is limited to acute conditions with onset in the 2-week reference period prior to the interview week. Acute conditions also include current deliveries, normal or complicated, and current complications of pregnancy and the puerperium. Acute conditions must have had activity restriction or medical attention in order to be included in the survey statistics.

Acute conditions, as defined, are given a supplementary 1-digit code number identifying them as acute, and are sorted for tabulation under Recode #2 categories on this basis. Also, the incidence of acute conditions is tabulated under Recodes #1 and #2 only for those conditions with onset in the 2-week period prior to interview.

<u>Content</u>: Each line of the recode contains the following elements: Recode #2 number, title summarizing the contents of the category, Recode #1 inclusions, and rubric numbers from the International Classification of Diseases (ICD).

A summary listing of modifications which affect the use of the recode is shown as follows:

- (a) The letter "S" following an ICD rubric number means that this is a special number devised for survey purposes which is not to be found in the ICD.
- (b) Certain ICD rubrics are recoded to other locations within the list of rubrics; these recoded ICD rubrics are shown in parentheses in the recode listing.
- (c) A 4th digit "9" of any ICD rubric has been changed to "X" to avoid confusion with the use of ".9" as a 4th-digit denoting traumatic origin of a chronic condition.
- (d) The abbreviations "NOS" and "NEC" represent, respectively, "not otherwise specified" and "not elsewhere classified".
