February 22, 2005 -- Imputed Income Linkage Files and Documentation

The 2003 NHIS Imputed Family Income/ Personal Earnings files were revised to correct values of the variable RAT_CATI (ratio of family income to poverty threshold group) for 1,032 persons. The corrections affect persons in families consisting of one adult and three children, regardless of whether income was imputed. For persons in these families the calculation of the ratio of family income to poverty threshold has been revised to use the correct poverty threshold value (\$18,307 instead of \$183,072). The original edit had erroneously excluded records, resulting in valid data being eliminated. The Sample Adult file layout for variable DIBNDYR has been modified in order to correct the universe and to reflect the new frequencies of the variable's values. July 16, 2014 -- Corrected recode calculations

In 2003, some of the NAF "time since cancer screening test" recodes were miscalculated. The following code uses the same estimation method used in 2000, and is consistent with the methods used in 2000 by the National Cancer Institute and the Office of Analysis and Epidemiology, National Center for Health Statistics. This program (P3_Final_Recode.sas) recreates the recodes using the method referred to as Method "B" in the 2005 and 2008 CANRECO.SAS programs. These programs can be found on the data release web pages for these data years (http://www.cdc.gov/nchs/nhis/nhis_2005_data_release.htm and http://www.cdc.gov/NCHS/nhis/nhis_2008_data_release.htm, respectively). Additionally, modifications in this program allow for a higher number of months since last test. Data users interested in calculating the time since last colorectal exam, home fecal occult blood test, mammogram, pap smear test, or PSA test should run this program, which will generate the correct recoded values of months since last test (RCRE_MO2, RHFO_MO2, RMAM_MO2, RPAP_MO2, RPSA_MO2) and time category since last test (RCRE3B, RHFOB3B, RMAM3B, RPAP3B, RPSA3B). This program outputs a permanent SAS data set with the 10 recodes listed above along with identifiers (HHX, FMX, PX) that can be used to merge the corrected recodes with other NHIS data files.
